



## 2021 Full Training for Accredited Clinical Supervisors

Under the Accredited Register (AR) Scheme for Clinical Psychologists, Accredited Clinical Supervisor (ACS) is to provide clinical supervision in two situations (a) two-year clinical supervision for accredited clinical psychologists without post-qualification practice experience, and (b) remedial training for applicants for registration (via transitional arrangement) whose clinical training does not fulfil the registration requirements. An ACS is required to have at least 10 years of clinical supervisory experience and to successfully complete an approved Full Training programme in clinical supervision. The Full Training which consists of three components is endorsed by the Hong Kong Institute of Clinical Psychologists (HKICP). After successfully completing all three components of the Full Training, the participant may apply to HKICP to become an Accredited Clinical Supervisor.

<b>Training Contents</b>	<b>(1) Online Knowledge Assessment in October 2021:</b> Around 7 hours' private study time before attending the Skills Training Workshop to acquire knowledge in the registration criteria of clinical psychologists, administrative requirements of clinical supervision, legal and ethical issues in clinical psychology practice as well as clinical supervision. This will be followed by a formal assessment with a passing criteria of 80% in order to proceed to the Skills Training Workshop.
	<b>(2) Skills Training Workshop on 21-22 October 2021 (9:00 am – 5:00 pm)</b> It includes supervision skills for clinical psychology practitioners, evaluation on supervisees' competencies and training on reflective practice supervision. There will be demonstration and small group practice. <b>Venue: The HKFYGs Building, 21 Pak Fuk Road, North Point, HK</b>
	<b>(3) Competency-based assessment and evaluation</b> Assessment of supervisory competencies after the skills training to become an ACS; to be completed within six months after completing the Skills Training Workshop
