4 Pre deployment Phase

- **♦** A HA staff was involved
- **♦ Notification and need assessment**
- **♦ Preparation for deployment**
- **♦ Ready to go kit**

4 Operation Phase

- 1. Planning: e.g. meetings with government personnel, collection of information, assessment of service needs, service planning
- 2. Direct services: e.g. briefing to family members, contact & engagement, acute grief support

- 3. Client advocate
- 4. Liaison
- 5. Consultation / advice
- 6. Follow up plan
- 7. Protection from media exposure

4 Post Incident Support

- 1. For survivors/ relatives:
- **♦** Individual crisis intervention services
- Assessment and psycho education session/information to family members
- Coping with loss and change

2. Injured Survivors and their Families:

♦ Psychological services provided by 13 clinical psychologists in Prince of Wales Hospital, Tsang Kwan O Hospital, Tuen Mun Hospital, United Christian Hospital and Corporate Clinical Psychology Services of Hospital Authority

3. For Staff of Hospital Authority

- ♦ Activation of the Critical Incident Support Team (peer support services provided by trained staff volunteers)
- Crisis intervention planning meeting
- Crisis management briefings
- **♦ Individual/ group crisis intervention services**
- **♦** Consultation services
